MAJOR JACOB S. SIMPSON

Major Jacob Simpson was born in Baton Rouge, LA. He has over 15 years of military service and is a two time graduate of LSU. Maj Simpson earned a B.S. in Microbiology from LSU in 2000, graduating *Summa cum Laude*. Following graduation, he joined the United States Air Force through officer commissioning school. He began his Air Force career as a Logistics Planner. In that capacity, he served as the Installation Deployment Officer, then as the Chief of Command Post, at Kirtland AFB in Albuquerque, NM. After several years in the military, Maj Simpson was competitively selected for the Funded Legal Education Program, and while on active duty, Maj Simpson returned to LSU for law school in 2003. Maj Simpson graduated from the LSU Law School in the top 2% of his law school class in 2006 and became a Judge Advocate General in the Air Force.

As a JAG, Maj Simpson has held numerous positions across the country, including a position as prosecuting attorney at Minot Air Force Base, North Dakota; Medical Law Attorney at Keesler Air Force Base, Biloxi, MS; and Acquisitions Attorney at Eglin Air Force Base, Florida. Maj Simpson has deployed to the Middle East where he served as a Combat Ops JAG in the Air Operations Center. In that capacity, Maj Simpson oversaw the legal aspects associated with the rules of engagement and the targeting of enemy forces in support of Operation Enduring Freedom.

Since then, Maj Simpson separated from active duty and is now a JAG in the United States Air Force Reserves. Maj Simpson has returned to Baton Rouge where he is a health care attorney at the Breazeale, Sachse & Wilson law firm. Maj Simpson is also currently the Chair of the Louisiana State Bar Association Health Law Section.
